As our Participatory Art Initiatives (PAIs) progress through their early implementation stages, two of them — **Posidonia Art Reef** (Italy) and **Sea of Sounds** (Norway) — are already making waves across their communities and beyond.

Posidonia Art Reef: From Community Labs to the Blue District

Led by Posidonia Green Festival, Italy



The Posidonia Art Reef team has completed two vibrant **community labs** in **Bogliasco**, bringing together families, children, and local stakeholders to co-create visions for their underwater sculptures.

Their next milestone will take place on **14 November at Genoa's Blue District**, where the **artists' maquettes and bozzetti** will be presented and selected.


Technical progress is also advancing rapidly:

- The team has chosen **TechnoReef modules** as the structural bases for the sculptures.
- Negotiations are underway with suppliers for the **fabrication and 3D printing** of artworks.
- **Drafin Sub** will manage the offshore assembly in the Port of Genoa, and may also sponsor the deployment.
- **Regione Liguria, Demanio Marittimo, Comune di Bogliasco, and the University of Genoa** are collaborating on authorisations and environmental assessments.

Sea of Sounds: Echoes of Whales and Community

The Sea of Sounds collective continues to deepen its connection between marine life, sound, and community engagement. 
